Food Donors

When food businesses have surplus they can't sell, or they would like to donate, they contact NZFN.

New Zealand Food Network

NZFN receives, processes, sorts & stores donated food. Food is redistributed in manageable quantities to Food Hubs at no cost to them or the donor.

Food Hubs

NZFN Food Hubs are food charities with the capacity and infrastructure to receive pallets of food and distribute locally.

Food Hubs distribute donations to direct recipients & smaller community organisations.

Your donation has the power to ripple across the country, reaching numerous communities through our network. We can also work with you to continue to supply your established charity relationships.

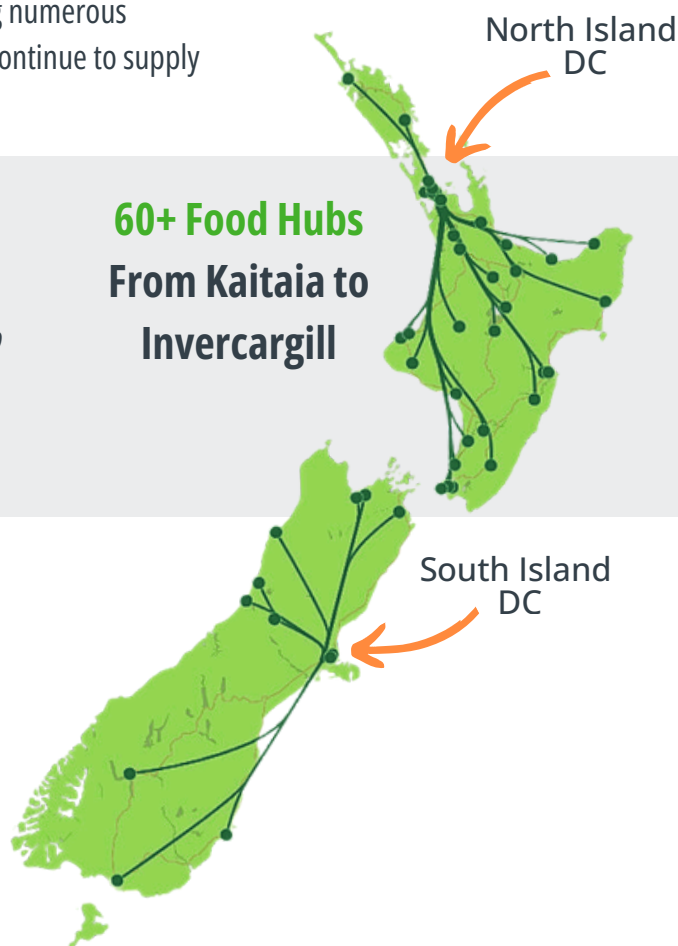
